Supplementary Regulations

1. Title & Authority

The meeting shall be known as the "Myrniong Historic Car Sprint" (hereinafter referred to as 'the meeting') and shall be a "Multi-Club Sprint", conducted under the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA and the National Competition Rules (NCR) of the Confederation of Australian Motor Sport Ltd (CAMS), the Speed Event Standing Regulations, these Supplementary Regulations, and any further regulations issued. CAMS Permit Number:- 305/1704/01

2. The Promoters

The promoter will be the Austin 7 Club Inc. Victoria. The organising committee shall be comprised of members of the Austin 7 Club Inc. Victoria.

3. Officials

4. The Course

The meeting will be held on Korobeit Road approximately 1.5 Kms north west of Myrniong Village. The road is bitumen and rises uphill to crest, with a finish line in a dip.

The timed portion of the road is 850 metres long, with the width varying between 3½ & 6 metres and a rise of approximately 60 metres.

5. Insurance

Competitors are covered by personal accident insurance in accordance with Appendix I, Part 2 of the N.C.R's.

6. Further Supplementary Regulations

The promoters reserve the right to issue further regulations, which shall have the same effect as these regulations.

7. Cancellation & Amalgamation

The promoters reserve the right, subject to the N.C.R's, to abandon, cancel or postpone the meeting, if there are insufficient entries, or if the conditions render the course unsafe.

8. Licences & Log Books

Drivers and entrants are required to hold a CAMS Level 2S Licence or higher.
CAMS Licence, competition record, club membership card and CAMS Log Book (if issued) must be presented at scrutineering.

9. Protests

Any protest entered must be in accordance with Part XII of the N.C.R's and be accompanied by the appropriate fee.

10. Opening & Closing of Entries

Entries will be received by the Secretary of the Meeting, Mr David Lowe, from Tuesday 1 March 2005, and will close on Friday 1 April 2005 - no late entries accepted.

Only front-engine cars accepted. Rear engined Production Sports Cars at the discretion of the race organising club. Vehicles capable of under 15 second quarter-mile times will not be accepted.

11. Refusal of Entry

The promoters reserve the right to refuse any entry, subject to the provisions of the N.C.R's.

13. **Multiple Entries**
Multiple entries and relief drivers will not be accepted.
14. **Selection of Entries**
The maximum number of entries shall be 100, and the promoters reserve the right to select entries from those offered in excess of this number in their absolute discretion. All entries are accepted at the discretion of the organising club.
15. **Awards**
There will be awards for the fastest time in each class and for the outright fastest time of day.
16. **Vehicle Numbers**
Preference for competition numbers may be indicated on the entry form, but the promoters reserve the right to allocate a competition number to each entry. Numbers affixed to cars must comply with Section 6, Schedule K of the CAMS Manual. Numbers will be available at the Race Control.
17. **Clothing**
(1) Safety helmets, complying with AS1698, or as otherwise listed in schedule D in the 2005 CAMS Manual are mandatory.
(2) Drivers are required to wear non-synthetic clothing, which fully covers the body, from neck to wrists and ankles (minimum requirement).
18. **Fire Extinguishers**
All cars shall carry a fire extinguisher in a properly charged condition, which complies with AS1841, except AS1841-2. (900g min. cap.)
19. **Scrutineering**
Scrutineering commences at 8.30am, Sunday, 17 April 2005, at the competitor form up area in Korobeit Road.
20. **Drivers briefing**
For all competitors: will be held near Race Control for all competitors at 9.45am – All drivers must sign on. Those who do not attend drivers briefing will incur a fine of \$50-00 and may be liable for exclusion
21. **Practice**
A practice run for each competitor will commence at 10.00am.
22. **Timing**
A timed practice run and three official runs will be staged.
23. **Intoxicating Liquor**
Alcoholic liquor is forbidden in the pits or race controlled areas during the meeting. Its consumption by any competitor or pit crew during the meeting is forbidden. In accordance with 145A, any driver found to have consumed alcoholic liquor shall be excluded forthwith from the meeting, in addition to any other penalty, which may be imposed by the stewards.
