FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

1. When are the classic cars and bikes appearing at Winton?

Cars and bikes will be racing on Saturday 29th and Sunday 30th May, 2010.

2. What are the vehicle categories?

The event features over 400 historic racing cars, motorbikes and sidecars from the 1920's to the 1980's.

3. What unusual cars are at the event this year?

Alfa Romeo 100th anniversary of the marque
Victorian Sporting Car Club
Ferrari Car Club
Jaguar Car Club 75th anniversary of the marque
Austin 7 Club Inc. 60th anniversary of the club in Victoria

4. Who runs the event?

The Austin Seven Club runs the event in conjunction with the HMRAV. The Austin seven club has been running HISTORIC WINTON for the past 34 years. All the officials and organising committee are volunteers. Contact the organisers on 03 54282689 for further information.

5. How can I enter the event?

If you have an eligible car and hold a competition licence, log onto www.historicwinton.org for an entry form.

6. Who can be an official?

Anyone can be an official at the event. If you do not have an officials licence, you can be issued with a trainee licence for the event. Contact the organisers on 03 54282689 if you wish to be involved.

7. What is the cost of general admission?

SUNDAY 30th May	\$30 per person	\$5 per person

Children under 14 years are admitted to the competition paddock FREE when accompanied by an adult.

8. Is concession available?

No, concession is not available due to the fact children under 14 years are admitted free.

9. What does a Paddock Pass mean?

This is all day access to the area where competitors' cars are parked. It does **NOT** include Pit Lane. Children under 14 years must be accompanied by an adult at all times.

10. Are family passes available?

No, family passes are not available as children under 14 who are accompanied by an adult are admitted free.

11. Is a programme available?

Programmes are a great source of information as well as a souvenir, and are available at the gate for only \$5.00 each.

12. What time does the racing start?

Saturday practice starts at 9.00 am and racing starts at 1.00 pm. Sunday racing starts at 9.00 am.

13. What times are the events on?

Event times are not finalised until close to the event. An event guide (approximate times only) is provided with the souvenir programme.

14. Can I buy food at the event?

Catering is available at the circuit including Kiosks, Liquor, Indoor restaurant, and food and coffee stalls.

15. Is parking available?

Yes. Parking is included with the purchase of your entry ticket.

16. Where can I stay for the weekend?

Camping is available at the raceway, or motel accommodation is available in the surrounding towns. See Winton Motor Raceway for a list of possible accommodation options. www.wintonmotorraceway.com.au

17. Can I camp at the circuit?

Camping is located in a designated camping area adjacent to the raceway. Camping is not permitted anywhere else on the circuit or circuit perimeter. All enquires to Winton Motor Raceway.

18. Do we need to book a site for camping?

No. Camp sites are on a first come, first serve basis.

19. Can I watch the races from the campsite?

No access to the venue is available from the camping area. An entrance ticket must be purchased from the entry gates of the Raceway.

20. What is the structure of racing over the weekend?

Cars and bikes will be practicing on Saturday morning. Cars and bikes will be racing on Saturday afternoon and all day Sunday. The car and bike events are grouped in blocks of around 3 to 4 races per block.

21. Are pets allowed at the circuit?

In the interest of safety, pets are **NOT PERMITTED** at the Raceway at any time.

22. Are we allowed to bring alcohol onto the premises?

Winton's Liquor Licence is for purchase of alcohol on-site only.

23. How can I get to the track?

Winton Raceway is located just off the Hume Highway near Benalla. Trains operate to Benalla and taxis operate from Benalla to the circuit.
